Comments: I selected unmet for my assessment due to me forgetting to assess the pt.s ankle for paresthesia. To correct that, I would ask pt. if he was experiencing any tingling or numbness while also assessing he could feel my hands on his ankles. Before laying my CVAD kit on the table I forgot to state that I would allow the table to dry, however when I set it down it had already dried. I unmet in my hand hygiene due to not doing HH before putting on my first pair of sterile gloves to remove the dressing. To correct this, after taking my exam gloves off I would put hand sanitizer on and then proceed to put my sterile gloves on. There was a break in my sterile procedure when I kept hovering my right arm over the sterile field when grabbing the chlorhexidine and the rapid-dry. To keep from breaking sterility, I would grab everything with only my hand in the sterile field, and stepping back so nothing crosses over my sterile field but my sterile gloves. I also didn't state that the chlorhexidine dried, so before putting the rapid-dry on, I would let the chlorhexidine dry fully before proceeding with the procedure. Before leaving the patients

room I forgot to ask if the pt. was in a good position. So before leaving, I would ask if he needed anything else from me or would like for me to position him in a more comfortable position.
