Comments:

I failed to tell the patient the duration of the procedures. Next time, I will need to inform the patient of how long it will take for me to do what I came to do.

I did not assess the central line before administering the medication. In the future, I will need to assess the site prior to giving the medication to ensure that it is safe to administer.

After giving the medication, I capped the lumen before I clamped it. To fix this I will need to clamp first before I cap the lumen when using the central line.

I marked the sterile procedure as unmet because I crossed over my sterile field. I need to be more aware next time of my elbow crossing over and not reaching further than the cuff of my sterile gloves. I also threw the wrapper of the dressing on the patient. I am not sure if it contaminated the site or not. However, next time I need to be more careful about where I drop the wrapper. I also forgot to tell the patient to turn their head and not breathe on the site. I need to remember next time to inform the patient not to face the insertion site as I change the dressing.

I also did not teach about the CVAD dressing change. I should have given a reason for the change and explained that they should not get the dressing wet. In the future, I need to remember to teach about what I am doing and why.

I do not know which category it falls in, but I also left the medication bin in the room upon leaving. I set the CVAD kit on top of it and did not grab it. I need to be more mindful of where I put my stuff and make sure not to leave the bin in the patient's room.

I also left my badge in my pocket. While it does not affect this patient directly, it is breach in security for the hospital as the staff should be wearing their badges. Next time, I need to remember to put it back on.
