GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

0830, admit diagnosis is closed displaced subtrochanteric fx of right femur w/ routine healing subsequent encounter, pt is sitting up in bed talking to nurse

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Alert & oriented x4, sensation intact x4 to dull & sharp, HGTW is strong on both right & left, pt is steady when they stand and walks w/ walker. speech is not slurred, pt speaks english, PERRL both are reactive to light dilated to a 2mm

Comfort level: Pain rates at 0 (0-10 scale) Location: NA

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

patient interacts w/ nurse appropriately, patient is friendly w/ staff

HEENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

HEENT symmetrical w/ no drainage, dentition intact, nodes not palpable, patient swallows without difficulty, oral mucosa pink & moist

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

chest configuration is symmetrical, breath sounds clear in all lobes, posteriorly and anteriorly, respiration rate is 16, breathing is equal and unlabored, pt is breathing w/out distress, pattern is equal

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S1 and S2 audible on auscultation, apical and radial rate is 63, S1 and S2 are equal, radial pulse 2+ on both right & left, pedal pulse is 2+ on both right & left, pedal & radial pulses are equal in pattern
