### Documentation Assignments

1. Document your initial focused assessment of Eva Madison.

**1. My initial assessment was the pain assessment using the FACE scale. I made sure to ask all of the questions that were relevant to how she was feeling and looking. She said she was a 4/10, and her pain was in her stomach due to her gastroenteritis.**

**Risk for electrolyte imbalance**

**risk for Hypovolemia**

3. Referring to your feedback log, document the nursing care you provided and Eva Madison's response.

**I identified the patient and family to make sure that she is safe.**

**I assessed her pain and she was very cooperative.**

**I checked all of her vital signs. Her respirations were equal, heart rate was very elevated and her systolic blood pressure was a little low.**

**I educated her and her mother on how she can start eating with her illness. Mother responded well and so did her daughter.**

4. Document the patient teaching that you would provide for Eva Madison and her parents before discharge, including teaching related to contact isolation precautions and diet progression.

**I would teach them that no one can go near Eva without gloves and a gown and to make sure to wipe down all of the surface very well with bleach. Make sure everyone washes their hands prior to leaving the room really well.**

**I would also teach them to slowly start feeding Eva full, dense, healthy foods such as fruits and vegetables. I would advise them to stay away from soda and any other drink that may irritate her stomach.**
