



# Board Vitals Overview

2. Select LOG-IN




3. Enter email address  
Initial password: boardvitals


4. Under Select Question Banks - Select NCLEX-RN



5. Select New Custom Quiz




6. Choose your Quiz Mode (Explanations of each provided)
