The Texas Board of Nursing and Disciplinary Committee revoked Mandy Anderson's Nursing Licenses from formal charges of sexual abuse to a child. She admitted to the Southlake Police Department of having sex with a minor from September through December in 2015 and was booked on charges of sexual assault of a child. The committee agreed that Mandy Anderson poses a threat to the general public and patients that are under her care if she continues to practice with her nursing license therefore it was denied after a meeting was held on June 9, 2020, in Austin, Texas. Universal Competencies are critical elements established for nurses to practice professionalism and to have a solid ethical and moral values to protect patients from being victims of abnormal behaviors and physical assaults that could harm them from these acts. The Universal Competency of Professional Role is an important guide to maintain and practice for nursing staff on interactions with patients, peers, and staff so boundaries and relationships do not get broken outside the professional environment and logical reasoning those relationships were established in the first place, to provide care for the patients. The prudent nurse would have reported the sexual assault to the police to establish safety for the child and to any employer the accused nurse practiced in to keep patients safe from these sexual acts.
