Type of action taken against the license: Reprimand with Stipulations

Daniel Brown was reprimanded and given special stipulations of classes that he had to complete. He also was placed on probation for a period of a year and not allowed to practice outside of Texas. What Mr Brown did was physically and aggressively grabbed a patient. He then shook him and forced him down into his bed. He raised his voice and yelled at the patient on several occasions causing emotional, physical and psychological harm. This was a failure of many universal competencies. First he failed in safety and security by ignoring professional interactions. For emotional safety and security he did not promote trust and respect. He did not use communication to be consistent with the patient needs. He did not use human caring by not treating the patient with respect and dignity and he did not listen to the patient's needs. In professional role, he did not interact with the patient in a professional manner and he interfered and disrupted the patient's treatment of care.

What he should have done was remove himself from the room and consult with a peer that he needs a time out. Time to recollect himself and think and reflect on the situation and how to better provide care for the patient without violence. If I was on staff that night the moment I heard him shouting I would have given him money to go down to the café and buy us both a coke or a coffee. By getting out of the situation for a moment could have prevented further unacceptable actions and given him time to cool off might have made him realize how important we are to our patients.
