Valproic Acid	Anticonvulsant	Seizures	75mg liquid NG BID			Abdominal pain, diarrhea, N/V, tremors, indigestion	1. Black Box Warning: Life threatening pancreatitis, complete hepatic failure have occurred. 2. Baseline VS and Labs 3. Monitor I's and O's for dehydration. 4. Report any pain to nurse.
