Use call light for assistance with movement due to effects of dizziness, confusion, and lightheadedness. 2. Teach patient and family about potential side effects to mental health such as anxiety, delusions and disassociation. 3. Monitor LOC due to sedation effects of medication. 4. Teach patient and family to take this medication as prescribed and ensure to not miss doses due to weakening the effects on seizure treatment; possible breakthrough seizure activity.
Polyethylene Glycol Powder (Miralax)	Osmotic Laxative	Treatment of Constipation	17g Oral Daily			Anaphylaxis N/V/D	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teach patient and family to report diarrhea more than 3 times a day due to possible dehydration and further electrolyte imbalances. 2. Teach pt. and family about

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							<p>contraindication if bowel blockage is present; monitor any present of blood in stool as this may be a symptom of an obstruction.</p> <p>3. Strict monitoring of Intake and Output due to excess loss in comparison to intake; further electrolyte imbalance.</p> <p>4. Auscultate bowel sounds x4 to monitor hyperactivity of bowels, which may signal overactive bowel movements and stomach upset.</p>
Valporic Acid (Depakene)	Anti-convulsant	Treatment of Seizures and Bipolar Disorder	75 mg/1.5 mL Oral BID			Teratogenic Anaphylaxis Altered mood	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Obtain daily weights due to increased risk of sudden weight gain. Use call light when moving in bed due to side effect of lightheadedness and dizziness. Teach patient and family about proper hair hygiene and care due to side effect of hair loss. Monitor bowels and have patient reported any N/V/D due to medication often causing gastrointestinal upset.

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
