Monitor patient and teach patient/caregiver to report N/V/D. 2. Encourage patient and caregiver about intake of fluids to help reduce the side effect of constipation. 3. Use call light when rising out of bed due to dizziness and lightheadness. 4. Raise the HOB to aid and assist with possible SOB or respiratory depression side effect.
Piperacillin-Tazobactam (Zosyn)	Antibiotic	Bacterial Infection	2240 mg IVPB TID		Diluent: Normal Saline Concentration: 2240mg/56 mL      Rate: 56mL/hr	Anaphylaxis	1. Monitor and Auscultate BS due to side effect of N/V/D, heart burn and constipation. 2. Encourage oral intake of fluids to help side effect of diarrhea that could lead to dehydration. 3. Teach patient and caregiver the importance of finishing antibiotics as prescribed to help prevent reoccurrence or

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							rebound effects of infection.  4. Teach caregiver and patient to report any burning, itching, redness, or swelling at the IV site due to possible infiltration or extravasion.
Famotidine (Pepcid)	Antacid	Treatment of ulcers, GERD	11mg IVP BID		e: Normal Saline IVP: 11 mg/10 mL Rate: 2 minutes	N/V/D Mood changes Insomnia	1. Monitor LOC of patient due to possible mood changes, headache and/or confusion. 2. Encourage oral intake of fluids to prevent the side effect of constipation. 3. Teach caregiver about possiblity of insomnia side effect; teach guided imagery 4. Use call light when getting OOB due to possible dizziness or lightheadedness.
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
