Acetaminophen	Analgesics non-narcotic	To treat mild pain	340mg IVP Q6H	Yes	IVP: no dilute needed give over 15 min	-constipation -HA -N/V -insomnia -atelectasis -agitation -diarrhea	1. do not take more than 4000mg in 24hrs 2. monitor liver functions (AST/ALT) 3. monitor BUN and creatine levels 4. report if pt has N/V, breathing problems, and abdominal pain because it might mean the pt has an acetaminophen toxicity
Famotidine	Ulcer drug	To treat or prevent stomach ulcers	11mg IVP Q12H	Yes	IVP: normal saline, give over 2 min	-headache -diarrhea -dizziness -constipation -n/v -muscle cramps -hepatitis	1. report tightness in chest 2. report if you have a rash, pruritus, urticaria 3. monitor renal function 4. report if there is blood in stool
Piperacillin-Tazobactam	penicilin	To treat abdominal infections	2240mg IVP	Yes	IVP: normal saline, administer over 30min	-diarrhea -HA -N/V -fever -HTN	1. monitor liver functions (AST/ALT) 2. monitor for seizures and tell family to report any seizure like activity 3. report any blood in stool or urine

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						-dyspepsia - thrombocytopenia -seizures	4. monitor renal functions
Morphine	Analgesics (narcotic)	To treat moderate to severe pain	1.12mg IVP PRN Q3H	Yes	IVP: normal saline, push over 5 mins	-pruritus -urinary retention -vomiting -constipation -HA -somnolence -abdominal pain -respiratory depression	1. Black Box: not recommended for single-dose IV, IM, or Sub-Q administration due to risk of overdose 2. monitor patient for the development of addiction to this medication 3. monitor for respiratory depression 4. teach patient to report constipation and difficulty breathing
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
