

Module 3 CVPV Medication List

Drug therapy to prevent and dissolve thrombi

- Anticoagulants
 - Factor Xa and thrombin inhibitor – heparin
 - Factor Xa inhibitor - Low molecular-weight heparin (enoxaparin, dalteparin)
 - Vitamin K inhibitor – warfarin
 - Medication antidotes – protamine sulfate, vitamin K
- Antiplatelets
 - Salicylates – aspirin
 - ADP inhibitors – clopidogrel

Drug therapy for hypertension

- RAAS Suppressants
 - Ace inhibitors – captopril
 - ARBs – losartan
 - Direct renin inhibitors – aliskiren
- Calcium channel blockers – nifedipine
- Sympatholytics
 - Alpha₁ adrenergic blockers – doxazosin
 - Beta adrenergic blockers – propranolol, metoprolol
 - Centrally acting alpha₂ agonists – clonidine
 - Alpha/beta blockers – carvedilol
- Direct acting vasodilators- hydralazine

Drug therapy for heart failure

- Diuretics
 - Thiazide diuretics – hydrochlorothiazide
 - Loop diuretics – furosemide
 - Potassium-sparing diuretics – spironolactone
- Cardiac glycosides – digoxin

Drug therapy for coronary artery disease

- Antilipemic
 - HMG-CoA reductase inhibitors (statins)- atorvastatin
 - Fibrates – gemfibrozil
 - Niacin
- Antianginals
 - Nitrates – nitroglycerin, isosorbide dinitrate

Electrolytes important for cardiac function

- Potassium
- Magnesium
