ondost-eron	IV - 0.15 mg/kg 15 min PO - 4-8mg q4-5 hr	if IV, dilute in some of NS	nausea + vomiting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• report diarrhea/constipation</li> <li>• report CP</li> <li>• report urine retention</li> <li>• resp assessment - bronchospasms</li> </ul>
Levofloxacin	PO 500-750 mg daily	N/A	Respiratory infection UTI etc infections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• report tendon pain - aches tendon rupture</li> <li>• report loose stools</li> <li>• report numbness/tingling</li> </ul>
