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|  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It is <b>HIGHLY</b> recommended that you complete the HESI assignments the week they are listed in this document. The assignments are listed in this document for your convenience.</li> <li>Note the suggested and in some cases the required completion date/time for each assignment. All work must be completed by <b>0800 4/17</b> to move on to the next semester.</li> <li>To locate the HESI assignments, log in to your Evolve. Find the folder you want to work in, like “Clinical Skills”. Click on that folder.</li> <li><b>Skills:</b> Click on “Course Calendar”. Go to the last month of this course which is April. You will see the list of skills assignments. Click on the assignment you want. You can retake a skills quiz but note that the quiz grade for each assignment is <i>averaged</i>. i.e. Score 70% on first attempt &amp; 90% on second attempt– average is 80%. But score a 20% on first attempt and you will have to retake the quiz numerous times to bring up the average to the required 80%.</li> <li><b>Case Studies:</b> Click on the Case Study folder. Click on Assignments. Choose and then click on an assignment and it will open. You must score 80%. You can retake the Case Study quiz if you do not score 80% on the first attempt.
