Purpose	To introduce students to a specialty rotation they are interested in to help identify a good fit on a unit	To assign a student to a preceptor on a unit of interest to complete curriculum education requirements while preparing student for transition into practice. Help student and unit decide employment
Job duty expectations	Works as NT	Works as NT while completing IM8 preceptor expectations (120 clinical hours with assigned preceptor- can do anything with the nurse)
Uniform colors	Hunter green	SON uniform—navy bottoms ceil blue top
Badge	Nurse Tech badge to clock in, hang down badge that states IM7 Intern	Nurse Tech badge to clock in, hang down badge that states IM8 Intern but logs in Epic as student so they can chart and give meds
Hours to work	Minimum of 12 hours/pay period (3-4 hours, 1-8 and 1-4 hour, 1-12 hour shift), if student wants to work more than 12 hours, they will get permission from staffing office supervisor first, no over time, Hours worked are not part of school curriculum requirements	Minimum of 12 hours/pay period intern must work a full 12-hour shift with their preceptor, they will get permission from staffing office supervisor first, no over time, Hours worked are part of the 120 hours required for curriculum completion, students are not allowed to complete clinical hours on Tues or Wed.
School Clinical Work Responsibility	None, the student is strictly in a NT role—the school is only involved with identifying student interest, specialty rotation assignment and gathering evaluation data	Faculty IM8 has oversight of clinical experiences, faculty identify and assign available preceptors and ensure preceptors meet TBON requirements, they round on students and preceptors, faculty gather evaluations, faculty gather student schedules for 120 hours and send to staffing office supervisors to put into kronos, any extra hours worked above 120 is approved by staffing office manager and is assigned as NT to unit
