Vancomycin	beta lactams	antibiotic	←	75-100mg/kg day im/iv divided q6-8hr	N/A	reaction at injection site rash fever	1. pt must finish whole prescription.. don't stop abruptly 2. monitor vs 3. assess pt for any allergic reactions 4. get CBC for baseline
Ibuprofen	NSAID	relieve inflammation, pain, fever	N/A	5-10mg/kg/dose q 6-8pm	N/A	NSAIDs increases risk of serious and potentially fatal cardiovascular thrombotic events, including MI and stroke	1. assess pt for any allergic reactions to med 2. check urine and stool for blood to indicate signs of GI bleed 3. Teach caregiver appropriate way to administer medication 4. Reassess pt temp if they have fever
