

Tuesday, Week 3

Young parents with three children who are low socioeconomic status that are having difficulty making ends meet. One of their biggest expenses is food. They would like information on the following (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): where to get **food boxes** (do they need vouchers or something else), where do they serve **free meals** (days/times/locations), and **after-school snack packs** for their children.

Wednesday, Week 3

Hispanic low socioeconomic status teenage parents with infant twins that need to complete high school or get a GED so that they can gain adequate employment. They would like information on the following (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): who offers **GED classes** (and what is the cost), are there **alternative schools** in LISD, FISD, or CISD and what do they offer?

Tuesday, Week 4

Foster parents who have recently taken two school-age children due to CPS mandating that they be removed from their home due to child abuse and possible sexual abuse. The foster parents need information on the following (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): local agencies that work with **children who have been abused** and agencies that work with children who need **therapy** after abuse.

Wednesday, Week 4

Parents who have twins – one has an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and the other has Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder. They are interested in information on the following (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): places that specialize with **ASD** and with **ADHD**.

Tuesday, Week 5

An immigrant mother of two children has just moved to Lubbock from California after leaving her husband because of domestic violence. She needs to get a job but does not have any of her essential documents with her (social security card, birth certificate, driver's license, etc.) (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): she needs information on community agencies that provide these **essential documents** so that she can gain employment and agencies that could help her with **interviewing skills and employment?**

Wednesday, Week 5

Low-income family with a teenage girl who found out she is pregnant (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): they need information on agencies that provide **free or low-cost prenatal care** and information.

Tuesday, Week 6

A single mother who has two children, one school-age and one toddler, who has escaped domestic violence (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): needs information about **shelters** for her and her children for right now and about **low-income housing** once she gains employment.

Wednesday, Week 6

Two teenage parents that are having their first baby in three months (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): they are in need of **parenting classes** to increase their limited knowledge about raising a child & they also could use information about **car seats** and other things that they will need for an infant.

Tuesday, Week 7

A single mother with a toddler and preschooler who are having difficulty making ends meet (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): she would like information on **clothing closets** for her and her children and help with **utilities**.

Wednesday, Week 7

A couple with four children who live in poverty are in need of medical & dental assistance for their family as they have no insurance (need to select two agencies/schools/churches that would be helpful for them): any agencies that provide **free medical and/or dental services**, and how to sign up for **Medicaid**.
