This STD clinical was definitely meeting the needs of the Lubbock population. This place was busy, from new patients, to patients having to come back for further treatment. The rate of syphilis in Lubbock has gone up 300%. More & more of the patients are pregnant women, affecting the child.

Yes, the nurses were great about teaching the pt's about safe sex, and if they were infected, the nurses were good about reminding them when & when not to have sex. This clinic taught me so much about STD's & were very willing to help me learn as well.
