Acetaminophen	Analgesics	Treats fever and relieves mild to moderate pain	348.8mg PO (oral) Q6hrs. PRN	Yes Choose an item.	NA	Disorientation, pruritic, rash	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Give your child no more than 5 doses in 24 hrs 2. Give doses at least 4 hours apart 3. Give with food if it upsets stomach 4. Increase fluid intake

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Ibuprofen	NSAIDs	Helps relieve mild to moderate pain	230mg PO(Oral) Q6hrs. PRN	Yes Choose an item.	NA	GI bleeding, Intestinal perforation	1. Report bloody stools 2. Report blurred vision 3. If you wait until the pain has worsened, the medicine may not work as well. 4. Increase fluid intake
Odansetron	Antiemetics	Treats nausea and vomiting	2.3 mg IV push Q6hrs. PRN	Yes Choose an item.	10 mL saline flush before and after administration. Administer slowly for at least 2-3 min.	Malaise/fatigue	1. Get up slowly from a sitting position 2. Increase fiber and fluid intake to prevent constipation 3. Report abdominal pain or muscle spasm/stiffness 4. Report if N&V persists after 30 min of administration
Zinc Oxide	Topical; protectants	Prevent minor skin irritations such as burns, cuts and diaper rash	16% Topical PRN	Yes Choose an item.	NA	Hypersensitivity	1. Apply to clean diaper area following diaper change 2. Apply to thin film to affected area 3. Avoid the eyes 4. Keep it out of reach of children
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
