

Patient #1 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint  
 Arm pain - fell off a slide at the park and landed on left arm, fell at least 3 feet, pt is a 4 year old female. MRI showed a fracture on humerus (upper anterior)

Patient #1 Teaching  
 1. Keep swollen joint elevated  
 2. Rest the affected joint  
 3. ~~ibuprofen~~ ibuprofen q 4-6 hours  
 Discharge planning/Community Resources  
 1. Keep sling on in place but off at bedtime  
 2. Alternate ibuprofen + acetaminophen  
 3. Rest affected extremity, report any numbness or tingling

Patient #2 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint  
 15 year old ~~girl~~ <sup>female</sup> w/ 40 respiratory distress, has a tracheostomy in place, is legally blind and wheel-chair bound

Patient #2 Teaching  
 1. Suction-tracheostomy as needed  
 2. Monitor for s/s of resp distress  
 3. Keep patient comfortable  
 Discharge Planning/Community Resources  
 1. Keep on cpap machine  
 2. Watch for signs of wheezing  
 3. Watch for signs of coughing up blood

Question #1: What community acquired diseases are trending?  
 RSV (respiratory syncytial virus infection)  
 FLU (influenza)

Question #2: How does this unit debrief a traumatic event?
