Amlodipine	10mg tab oral daily		Used to treat high blood pressure, some types of angina and other conditions caused by coronary artery disease.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look for flushing 2. Look for edema 3. Report dizziness and help getting out of bed 4. Report palpitations and monitor BP and BPM
Atorvastatin	40mg tab oral daily		Used together with diet to lower blood levels of "bad" cholesterol and to increase levels of "good" cholesterol.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look for dark, strong odor urine. (may have UTI) 2. Report hoarseness 3. Report lower back or side pain 4. Look for stuffy/runny nose
Finasteride	5mg tab oral daily		Used to treat symptoms of benign prostatic hyperplasia in men with enlarged prostate.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look for signs of breast cancer 2. Report pain in testicles 3. Report depression 4. May cause trouble getting/keeping an erection
Glipizide	10mg tab oral twice a day with meal		Helps control blood sugar levels by helping pancreas produce insulin.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Report signs of hypoglycemia 2. Look for signs of anorexia 3. May cause gastralgia 4. May cause flatulence
Isosorbide Mononitrate ER	60mg tab oral daily		Dilates blood vessels, making it easier for blood to flow through them and makes it easier for the heart to pump.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. May cause light-headed feeling, take caution when ambulating 2. Can cause worsening angina pain 3. Report pounding heartbeat

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				4. Report fluttering in chest
Lamotrigine	200mg tab oral daily		An anti-epileptic medication to treat epileptic seizures in adults or can be used to treat bipolar disorder.	1. Report signs of Stevens-Johnson syndrome immediately 2. Can cause ataxia, use caution ambulating 3. May cause insomnia 4. May cause blurred vision
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Allergies: Budesonide- Formoterol Fumarate, Formoterol, Amitriptyline, Doxycycline, Hydrocodone, Nortriptyline, Penicillin's, and Pregabalin

Primary IV fluid and rate: Did not have fluids running
