0700 34yr old caucasian male admitted for small bowel obstruction, sepsis. General appearance for pt normal Cerebral palsy and contracted limbs.

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Pts LOC is oriented x2 person place. Limited speech. Pt exhibits good hand grips sensation intact. Limited coordination, all due to Cerebral palsy dx since birth → contracted limbs. Peria 3mm. Pt unable to voice/rate pain

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

Pt smiles when spoken to/questions asked. able to shake head to yes (no questions jerks limbs when touched before acknowledged limited interactions. CP dx

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

EENT symmetrical w/out deviations noted sclera white, NG tube in Dnare, green drainage color.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

No respiratory distress auscultated/visualized. Clear breath sounds auscultated upon inspiration/expiration of lung quadrants. Pt is on RA. Pt has slight chest distortion. (CP dx)

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S1 & S2 cardio sounds normal no a/b/rhythms auscultated. Bi-lat pedal & Bi-lat radial pulses 2+ strong → able to occlude.

Distended/guarded abd. Incision & staples
to midline of belly. Pt had small bowel resection
