Magnesium Sulfate	Anticonvulsant	To prevent seizures		Y N		Confusion, dizziness, low blood pressure, muscle weakness	1. closely monitor BP 2. if urine output <30mL, stop the mag 3. if magnesium serum level <8 stop the mag 4. if DTRs >2+, stop the mag
Meperidine	Opioids	Treat moderate to severe pain		Y N		Can slow breathing, severe constipation, serotonin syndrome	1. No driving while taking this medicine 2. teach to take med exactly as directed 3. high fiber diet, and fluids to prevent constipation 4. inform patient of potential addiction, OD, or death
Promethazine	Antihistamine Antiemetic	Allergic rxns Severe nausea		Y N		Severe drowsiness Light headedness	1. monitor for uncontrolled muscle movements 2. contraindicated for hx of respiratory problems 3. slowly get up to avoid orthostatic
