Keep hydrated 2. Should have 3 wet diapers q 24 3. Return to ER uncontrollable vomiting, NO BM, bloody diarrhea <p>Discharge planning/Community Resources</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. alt acetaminophen and Ibu q 3 PRN 2. Encourage fluid intake/pediatric 3. PCP f/u 3-5 days
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<p>Patient #2 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint 2:10</p> <p>Hit head, emesis and fever</p> <p>Diagnosis: enterorhinovirus Gastroenteritis Adenovirus</p>	<p>Patient #2 Teaching</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bring back to ED if seizures or slurred speech occur 2. May have 5ml kids Ibu 3. Encourage fluid intake to help w/ fever <p>Discharge Planning/Community Resources</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. PCP f/u 2. Admin zofran PRN for N/V 3. Mon. child closely for worsening symptoms
