

**Objective**

To provide students opportunities to enhance nursing judgment connecting theory to practice using EBP (Evidence Based Practice) learning material threaded throughout the curriculum.

**Instructions**

- Students must successfully complete the **required** learning activities (as outlined below).
- *Exact due dates and times are listed within the Course Calendar.*

**Grading**

- Graded activities will be used in overall course calculation:
  - **HESI Proctored Fundamentals Exam is 5% of the total IM4 grade.** Grades awarded will be as follows:
    - ✓  $\geq 850 = 100$
    - ✓ Below 850=HESI Conversion Score
  - HESI Adaptive Quizzes Medical-Surgical (x4) and Fundamentals (X3) are 5% of the total IM4 grade. Each adaptive quiz may be repeated to earn a higher level as desired. Grades will be awarded as follows:
  - Fundamentals (X3) Medical-Surgical (X4)
    - ✓ Any Fundamental below the novice level = 0 (The results will show up as a gray dot if you have not reached novice level)
    - ✓ Completion of the Fundamental modules means you reached novice level for all three required courses=100 (The result will show up as a pink dot for reaching the novice level)
    - ✓ Any Medical-Surgical below the novice level=0 (The results will show up as a gray dot if you have not reached the novice level)
    - ✓ Completion of the Medical-Surgical modules means you have reached the novice levels for all four required courses =100 (The result will show up as a pink dot for reaching the novice level)
    - ✓ **YOU MUST COMPLETE BOTH THE FUNDAMENTAL AND MEDICAL-SURGICAL MODULES TO RECEIVE YOUR ADAPTIVE GRADE**
    - ✓ **ALL ESSENTIAL PACKETS AND 3 CASE STUDIES MUST BE COMPLETED BY 11PM ON WEEK 7 FOR ADAPTIVE MEDICAL-SURGICAL GRADE TO COUNT**
- Non-graded required learning activities not being used for overall course calculation are to be completed in a *pass/fail manner*.
  - ✓ Each quiz can be taken more than once but the accumulated grades will be averaged for the final score.
  - Adaptive Quizzing has mastery levels shown as checkmarks.
  - **Drug Calculation must have a score of 85 or greater** by 11pm week 7 of IM4 HESI material closing date.
