Instructional Module 6 Learning Guide
Topic: Intrapartum Nursing

Learning Goals/Outcomes

Upon completion of this lesson, you will be able to:

- Teach the patient/family how to differentiate between true and false labor to determine when to go to the birthing facility.
- Identify the stages and phases of labor and compare the differences for the nulliparous and multiparous patient.
- Describe the admission, continued intrapartum assessment, nursing interventions, and emotional support used to care for the laboring patient, significant other and the family.
- Explain how the mechanisms of labor and components of the birth process affect the course of labor and vaginal birth.
- Describe the laboring patient's physiologic, psychological, and emotional responses; and the fetus physiological responses to labor.
- Describe the procedures, risks, precautions, contraindications, nursing considerations, and prioritization used for emergent situations.
- Examine the laboring patient's pain experience and describe the nursing care, the non-pharmacological and pharmacological pain management, and the benefits and risks of each type of pain management.
- Provide emotional support to the women experiencing an unexpected cesarean birth.
