Instructional Module 3 Learning Guide
Topic: Perioperative Nursing/ Pathology/ Pharmacology

Learning Goals/Outcomes

Upon completion of this lesson, the student will be able to:

- ❖ Identify the three phases of Perioperative Nursing
- ❖ Analyze and prioritize the essential elements of the preoperative, perioperative, and postoperative assessment and documentation of the physiological health status of the surgical patient
- ❖ Identify potential surgical risk factors for each patient in all three areas of perioperative nursing
- ❖ Analyze the components and purpose of informed consent
- ❖ Evaluate the importance of safety in the operating room regarding patients, equipment, and anesthesia
- ❖ Describe the signs and symptoms, etiology (including the main pharmacologic causes), and management of malignant hyperthermia
- ❖ Describe the properties of individual local anesthetics and other medications used in this setting and discuss their clinical uses and nursing responsibilities
- ❖ Identify and understand the preparation of a post operative patient to a room on the floor.
- ❖ Understand patient teaching for post-operative patients, e.g. incentive spirometry, use of Patient-Controlled Analgesia (PCA) device, multi-modal pain control, SED, and positioning a patient
- ❖ Identify the nursing responsibilities when administering opioids, NASIDS, nonopioid acting analgesics and opioid antagonists
