Vancomycin			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Severe systemic infections 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If you experience any ringing in your ears, please report 2. Please report if start experiencing any pain near IV site 3. If any skin irritation or rashes occur near IV site, please report 4. If you start experiencing any shortness of breath or trouble breathing, please report
Prednisone (Rayos)			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Exacerbations of acute scleriosis -Exacerbations of acute asthma 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please avoid eating foods enriched in sodium 2. Increasing potassium in your dietary intake or supplementing it is highly encouraged 3. Stay away from anyone that might have an infection 4. Report if you develop unusual or extreme lethargy
Levofloxacin (Levaquin)			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Bacterial bronchitis -UTI -Bacterial prostatitis -Pneumonia -Skin and skin structure infections -Bacterial sinusitis 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Report if you develop any muscle weakness 2. Report if you start to experience pain or inflammation in a tendon 3. Please report if you start to experience mild diarrhea 4. Report if you start to experience any tingling or numbness
Ondansetron (Zofran)			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Nausea/Vomiting 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please report if you start to develop chest pain 2. If you start to experience stiff or twitching muscles, please report 3. If you develop swelling or pain in your abdomen, please report 4. If taken at home, please keep medication at room temperature and keep away from light
