Pharm Immersion Lab Scenario 1

Scenario:

Date (today) Time (now) Pat Mahomes MR#1152022 admitted to Med-Surg unit with acute dyspnea related to Heart Failure. Labs, chest x-ray and complete bed rest ordered. History includes chronic COPD; Heavy smoker (2 pk/day), hypothyroidism, and glaucoma. NKDA.
Current VS: BP: 156/92 HR:74 RR: 24, T: 98.7°

Based on the scenario, the following medications have been ordered: clonidine patch, levothyroxine, brimonidine tartrate, and tiotropium bromide

Medication Orders:

1. Clonidine (Catapres-TTS-2) 0.2mg/day TD, apply every 7 days
2. Levothyroxine (Synthroid) 100 mcg PO daily 30 minutes AC breakfast
3. Brimonidine tartrate (Alphagan) 0.1% one drop OU three times a day
4. Tiotropium bromide (Spiriva) 2.5 mcg inhaler one puff daily
