

GRADE COMPUTATION EXAMPLE FOR IM5

Students are required to pass the clinical portion of the course and have a total grade average of 75% on Exams 1 - 4 prior HESI grade, Dosage Calculation Exam, and Poster Presentations being calculated in.

Example:

E1 - 90

E2 - 88

E3 - 92

E4 - 86

356 points ÷ 4 exams = **89%**

$89 \times .75$ (**75%**) = **66.75**

HESI Adaptive Quizzing - $95 \times .075$ (**7.5%**) = **7.125**

“In Their Shoes” Presentation - $88 \times .075$ (**7.5%**) = **6.6**

Dosage Calculation Proctored Exam $92 \times .05$ (**5%**) = **4.6**

HESI Specialty Exam $100 \times .05$ (**5%**) = **5**

$66.75 + 7.125 + 6.6 + 4.6 + 5 = 90.075$ Final Grade

***To calculate what you need to make on Exam 4 to meet the 75% requirement, take the total number of 300 points and subtract your grades from Exams 1, 2 and 3.**
