## Patient Report—cont'd

	Labs and diagnostics:	Valproic acid level, drug urine screen, and TSH, T3, T4 and free T4 were done on Monday 2200.
<b>Assessment</b>	Nurse's assessment:	Patient is manic with pressured speech, elevated mood, intrusive behaviour, irritability, and hyperactivity with inability to remain in chair or bed.
<b>Recommendation</b>	Plan of care:	Monitor for safety for nutrition, hydration, elopement risk, and sleep deprivation.
	Tests/results pending:	Valproic acid level is zero. Thyroid tests and drug urine screening are pending.
