amlodipine	PO 10mg daily		hypertension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -report any black and tarry stools or blood in urine - report to PCP if having dizzy spells - Be careful exercising or being in heat for too long - do not take any OTC medications for cough and cold without consulting with PCP
Lactulose	PO 30mL daily		Constipation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Increase mobility and water intake to aid in bowel movements - Monitor glucose levels as it may increase you blood glucose levels - Do not take other laxatives in conjunction to this medication - Report any muscle cramps or an irregular heartbeat
heparin	SQ 5000 units BID		anticoagulant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Report any unusual bleeding or bruising immediately - Use an electric razor, not a razor blade when shaving - Report black, tarry stools or blood in urine - Avoid ETOH and NSAIDS

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pantoprazole	PO 40mg daily		Stress ulcer	-Avoid ETOH and NSAIDs -Take at the same time every day -may experience headache and dry mouth -it is best to take this medication 30 minutes before meals
