What is happening in the body?

FGR is a condition in which the baby is smaller than expected for gestational age.

-poor placenta function



What am I going to see during my assessment?

small in size, below estimated percentile in abdominal girth, head circumference & length.



What tests and labs will be ordered?

Colposcopy

S/S

abdominal and pelvic pain

~~abdo~~ abnormal vaginal discharge



What trends and findings are expected?

Infant is usually going to be trending below the expected age compared to its peers.




What medications and nursing interventions/treatments will you anticipate?
meds: multivitamin to help improve nutrition.
interventions would be to keep a scheduled feeding and stay consistent.



How will you know your patient is improving?
↑ in weight, height and percentile



What are risk factors for the diagnosis?
↑ risk of autism
learning disabilities



What are the long-term complications?
Women: infertility, abortion or ectopic pregnancy, ↑ risk of contracting HIV
men: reproductive health complications



What patient teaching for management and/or prevention can the nurse do?
teach to continue nutritive feeding and include a healthy/full diet to ↑ overall health.
prevention is to incorporate prenatal care and regular check-ups
