

## OB Simulation Day 1 & 2 – Student Absence Instructions

The absence make-up for day one of the OB simulation will be replaced with similar activities that you would have missed.

An absence on **day one** requires completion of the **Patient Preparation Worksheet** plan of care for the following patients:

- Cynthia Williams
- Sarah Rogers
- Brittany Spears

An absence on **day two** requires completion of the **Patient Preparation Worksheet** plan of care for the following patients:

- Alice Jones
- Baby Boy Jones
- Ashley Smith

Follow the instructions below of completion of **Patient Preparation Worksheets** for the patient assigned on the day you were absent:

- 1) Review the patient's prenatal record to obtain the patient's medical and obstetrical history, her initial pregnancy lab work, additional pregnancy lab work, and the assessments from her prenatal office visits. Use the information obtained to identify possible risk factors and/or complications you should include in your plan of care.
- 2) Next review the SBAR report from the off-going nurse for the assigned scenarios.
- 3) Now utilize the **Patient Preparation Worksheet** to develop your plan of care for each assigned **scenario(s)**
- 4) Upload the completed **Patient Preparation Worksheet** assigned for day one into your individual LMS drop box.

### **Final Step: Scholarly Article Review**

- 5) Next find a scholarly nursing article related to SBAR communication or teamwork and write a two-page report in APA format regarding how you plan to incorporate the information you learned from the article into your nursing practice.
- 6) Upload your completed report into your individual LMS drop box.
- 7) Last you will present how you plan to implement the information you learned from your article into your nursing practice and the plan of care you developed for Cynthia and Baby Boy William using your Critical Thinking-OB Simulation Report Sheet during a post clinical conference.
