Type of action taken against the license: Warning with Stipulations

- To prevent the action being taken by nurses:
  1. the hospital could have a verification system for medicine administration. To make sure the medicine has to be scanned before document administration.2.
  2. Ensure all the registered nurses were provided with proper training for document annual. 3.
  3. Make sure patient and nurse ratio is reasonable.
- Identify ALL universal competencies were violated and explain how.
  1. Safety: against 7 rights of medication administration-Violent right documentation.
  2. Documentation: eMAR medication scan. False documentation.
- Prudent Nurse's action  
If prudent nurses found out about this situation, the proper action would be:
  1. Immediately report the false action to the charge nurse or nurse manager.
  2. Document what happened and report in detail.
  3. Follow the hospital protocol for proper action to reduce the harm to the patient.
