

## Modified CPE Key Points Lab 1A & 1B

**AIDET:** Acknowledge, Introduce, Duration, Explanation, and Thank you (done during interaction with the patient)

### **Universal competencies:**

- Knock before entering the patient's room.
- Introduce yourself.
- Hand hygiene
- ID the patient and verify allergies (chlorhexidine or betadine).
- Communicate with the patient.
- **Maintain asepsis!**
- **Safety**

### **Sterile Procedure: Central Venous Access Device (CVAD/CVL) & Foley Insertion (You will have two self-corrects)**

- Hand hygiene and clean the bedside table for the sterile procedure.
- **Maintain asepsis!**
- Foley insertion
- Central Venous line dressing change (verbalize "I will change the needleless ports")

### **Teaching:**

- The procedure
- The assessment
- At the end of CPE **verbalize** documentation of the procedure and response to the procedure

### **Safety: before exiting the room**

- Make sure the bed is at its lowest position.
- HOB rails up x 2
- Bed locked
- Call light within reach
- Instruct the patient to call for help or assistance.
- **4 Ps:** Pain, potty, position, and personal possessions (done when you finish, before exiting the patient room)
