1. What did you observe during the day? Were there any specific procedures that were able to participate in or observe? RPR, TPPA, test for syphilis screening. In RPR

test we take serum sample and measure if any antibodies present. We also have a QC group on the testing chart to make sure we got accurate result.

2. What was the best/most interesting part of the experience?

The med tech gave me a short presentation about different stages and symptoms of syphilis. It sometime can be overlook or mixed with other disease.

3. Is a community nursing position something that you would consider working in? Why or why not?

It definitely is an interesting site. They have very regular schedule and shift.

If the salary is similar to hospital nurse I would totally consider.

4. Do you feel like this community site met the needs of the population they serve? Why or why not?

Yes, the city STD clinic provide low cost for STD screening. A testing kit cost 50\$ but they only charge people 20\$. They also provide free treatment if people go to hospital could cost a lot of money for treating STD.

Do you feel that patient teaching in this community site was adequate? Why or why not?

I didn't see pt teaching, But they gave me a presentation they use for

community teaching. I learned symptoms/stages of syphilis. and high risk behaviors.

I also learned about the sad history of "Tuskegee". US public health service was doing a untreated syphilis study among black males in Tuskegee from 1932-1972. Although treatment was invented in 1940s but men in study was told not to treated. Many of these black men died eventually. In 1997 president Clinton issues presidential apology for this incident.

I observed general STD screening for HIV, syphilis. For HIV we do finger poke for blood sample the test will take 20 min to show result. We also take blood sample, urine sample, and throat swab samples.

I get to see the whole process from greet to pt. Ask for their med hx. Also we obtain detail sex hx. And we do the screening. Help me understand what is it like to work in clinic.

3. Is a community nursing position something that you would consider working in? Why or why not?

Yes, I like the small clinic feeling. People have regular schedule and holidays. The only thing is it might not pay as well as some facility/hospital.

4. Do you feel like this community site met the needs of the population they serve? Why or why not?

Yes since 2019 syphilis in Lubbock already grown 500%. The city clinic help to screen and test all sample for 5 other hospital including covenant.

5. Did you witness patient teaching? What general things were taught to this population?

Do you feel that patient teaching in this community site was adequate? Why or why not?

Yes, STD is spread among all age group. If you have a new partner remember to use condom all time even in oral sex. If one person have symptom / tested for HIV / syphilis all their partners will be called and go through screening process. Also fetal examination is important. A lot of pregnant women doesn't know the importance of fetal examination. Some STD can lead to maldevelopment to the newborn. I think the nurse in the clinic ~~teach them~~ educate their patient well and they also do community presentation from time to time.
