Type of action taken against the license: Warning with Stipulations

1. Dec 25, 2016. Staff RN at Dell Children's Medical Center, Austin, TX. Failure to document CHG bath was performed. – Against safety and security, Document in the universal competency.
2. Dec 27, 2016. Staff RN at Dell Children's Medical Center, Failure to properly label the lab specimen. RN did not realize there were two separate patients and placed the wrong patients information on the specimen. –Against eMAR document scan, against 7rights for right patients.
3. Mar 29,2017. Staff RN at Dell Children's Medical Center, Failed to administer the intravenous immunoglobulin to patient. Result IVIG was not completely infused, could result in non-efficacious treatment of the patient's recurrent fever.—Against 7rights for medication administration(wrong time).
4. April 5, 2017. Staff RN with Dell Children's Medical Center. Failed to document the daily sage wipe/hibiscus bath, --- Against 7rights(wrong document).
5. May 9, 2017. Staff RN at Dell Children's medical Center, Austin, TX. Failed to administer Sinemet to the patient. On eMAR noted as rescheduled. Could lead to non-efficacious treatment.--- Against 7rights of medication administration(wrong time).

1. Improve the medication administration training.
 2. provide safety and security annual training.
 3. Make the new RN employee familiar with the hospital medication administration protocols.
 4. provide continuous education and supervision by the hospital and working floor.
 5. improve technology such as a barcode scanning system to eliminate error.

 1. Safety and security. Against 7 rights for medication administration, failure to document CHG bath, and wrong label specimen.
 2. Documentation. Failure to administer intravenous immunoglobulin and Sinemet at the correct time. Which is against the 7rights of medication administration and could lead to ineffective treatment.
