**GENERAL INFORMATION** (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

0800, pt was admitted with pyelonephritis.  
pt was awake sitting up in bed

**Neurological-sensory** (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

A+O x4, PERRLA, responses to sharp + dull sensations, moves all extremities, strong bilateral HGTW, easy to understand speech, + pt makes coordinated movements

Comfort level: Pain rates at 0 (0-10 scale) Location: NA

**Psychological/Social** (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

No family @ bedside, acts appropriately w/ staff & has cheerfull affect.

**EENT** (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

trachea midline, pt denies drainage from eye, nose, mouth or ears, dentition intact, no distention of nodes, no difficulty swallowing.

**Respiratory** (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest is symmetrical, equal + unlabored resp. breath sounds CTA w/ regular rhythm, pattern + depth, @ rate of 18

**Cardiovascular** (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S1 + S2 auscultated w/ regular rate, rhythm + pattern, 65 bpm, 2+ radial + pedal pulses bilaterally, capillary refill 2+.
