- Examine basic components of conception and embryonic, placental, and fetal development
- Differentiate methods for diagnosis of pregnancy and determination of gestational estimated date of delivery (EDD)

Antepartum Period / Prenatal Care / Antenatal Screening

- Assess the physiological and psychological changes during pregnancy
- Determine the fundamental elements of prenatal care and the indications for antenatal assessments/testing
- Explore pre-existing medical conditions and pregnancy-related complications and their impact on the pregnant patient and the fetus(es)
