I observed the questions that are asked to the patients. First they do an HIV test through a finger-print. Then they do blood draws (which I got to participate in.) Then they pee in a cup to check for gonorrhea & Chlamydia and I would place their urine in a tube. I also created labels, put together sacs, drew lines on the urine cups, and had a tour of the lab.

The most interesting thing for me was watching how the HIV test works and what the results were.

I have an open mind about it because I would get really good at doing blood draws.
