Hydrocortisone	50mg/12ml IVP Daily	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dilated with NS - 50mg/12ml - Pushed Over 3 Minutes 	This pt. is taking this medication to manage pain & inflammation.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This medication may cause stomach bloating. 2. This medication may cause trouble sleeping. 3. Report new pain in joints, bones, or muscles.
Insulin Glargine -Hydro	20 Units SQ Daily		This pt. is taking this medication to manage hyperglycemia.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This medication may cause a rash. 2. Report rapid weight gain. 3. Inform HCP of swelling in the feet or ankles.
Magnesium Oxide	800mg PO Daily		This pt. is taking this medication to elevate intravascular magnesium levels.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Report any rectal bleeding. 2. Inform HCP of inability to have a BM. 3. Monitor for tarry stools.
