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| <p>Please read the following instructions carefully:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is HIGHLY recommended that you complete the HESI assignments the week they are listed in this document. • Note the suggested and in some cases the required completion date/time for each assignment. All work must be completed by 0800 4/11. • To locate the HESI assignments, log in to your Evolve. Find the folder you want to work in, like "Clinical Skills". Click on that folder. <p>Skills, Drug Calc, or Pharmacology Assignments: Click on "Course Calendar" in the appropriate folder. <u>Go to the last month of this course, which is April.</u> You will see the list of skills or drug calc assignments. Click on the assignment you want. You can retake a quiz but note that the quiz grade for each assignment is <u>averaged</u>. i.e., Score 70% on first attempt & 90% on second attempt- average is 80%. If you score 20% on the first attempt, you will have to retake the quiz numerous times to bring up the average to the required 80%.</p> <p>Case Studies: Click on the Case Study folder. Click on Assignments. Choose and then click on an assignment and it will open. You must score 80%. You can retake the Case Study quiz if you do not score 80% on the first attempt.
