Do not stop abruptly, can cause greater risk for seizures. 2. Watch for angioedema, s/s: swelling of hands, feet, throat, trouble breathing. 3. Watch for low blood cell counts, can lead to bleeding issues. Infection s/s: Fever, chills, st. 4. Skin assessments often due to risk of Steven Johnson Syndrome.

IVP: 65mg/mL, 36mg, x12 hours. 0.55mL= 36mg/65mg	Sleep disturbances, overactive, uncontrolled eye movements, respiratory depression.	1. Must perform resp. assessment due to risk for resp. depression. 2. Could cause SOB, watch accessory muscles and monitor respirations. 3. Monitor blood cells, could cause anemia. 4. Monitor IV site could cause tissue damage if drug leaks.
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
