## ON OR ABOUT AUGUST 31, 2019

- R.N. Fathi Enders, with Kindred Hospitals, erroneously administered 1 unit of packed red blood cells to patient SK
- Administered without orders
- July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020, received “WARNING WITH STIPULATIONS, DEFERRED”.
- 45 days to complete a Board-approved KSTAR program.
- 3 years deferred and a “Single State License”





- **Enders should have called the physician to verify the orders and the patient's information.**
- **Enders should have taken the initiative to contact the supervisor's supervisor for putting pressure on him to administer the transfusion due to the unit being opened.**
- **Enders should have also checked the patients' chart for diagnosis and lab values that would help verify the need for a blood transfusion.**
