

NURSING JURISPRUDENCE EXAM (NJE)

The Texas Board of Nursing (TBON) requires individuals who are applying for nursing licensure to pass a Nursing Jurisprudence Examination (NJE) in addition to the NCLEX-RN, prior to receiving his/her permanent RN license.

- The NJE will be taken at home by the student during the 8th instructional module.
- The exam is timed and must be completed within a 2-hour time limit.
- TBON and CSON expect students to maintain the highest ethical standards when taking the jurisprudence exam.
- **The student must submit proof of completing the NJE to your instructor advisor by week 4 of the instructional module.**

Note: The student is given one opportunity to print the NJE certificate. The student must print the certificate immediately after completion and before they log out of the exam. This also means the student must take the NJE on a computer that has printing capabilities.
