1 Communicable disease characterized by white then red "strawberry" tongue	2 Communicable disease which is the greatest threat to an unborn baby
6 Permanent contraindication to any vaccine	3 Interventions for this communicable disease include soft/liquid foods and warm or cool compresses
10 Temporary contraindication to a live virus vaccine	4 Produced by the immune system in response to a vaccine
11 Vitamin A supplementation may be recommended for a child with this disease	5 History of intussusception is a contraindication for this vaccine
12 Used to stimulate the body's immune response against diseases	6 Treatment for immunocompromised patients diagnosed with varicella
14 Communicable disease characterized by a vesicular rash which is extremely pruritic	7 Process by which a person becomes protected against disease through vaccination
15 Vaccine responsible for decreased cases of bacterial meningitis in children	8 Spread of disease is stopped when the majority of the population is vaccinated
17 Most effective prevention method for controlling the spread of any communicable disease	9 Type of immunity when antibodies are transferred from an animal or human to another human
19 Disease with respiratory assessment as a priority	13 Type of vaccine which cannot replicate
20 Vaccines which are a weakened form of the "wild" virus or bacterium	14 Required by law to be given with each dose of vaccine
