**GENERAL INFORMATION** (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

0905. AKI, patient looks clean and well kept

**Psychological/Social** (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

Patient was kind with staff. but could get agitated very easily.

**HEENT** (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

HEENT symmetrical with no drainage. No palpable nodes. Patient could swallow medications and soft foods easily. Dentition intact with no missing teeth.

**Respiratory** (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest symmetrical with clear breath sounds in all lobes except for right upper lobe with inlate. Rate of 20 with regular rhythm and pattern but very shallow.

**Cardiovascular** (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S<sub>1</sub> and S<sub>2</sub> audible with regular rate and rhythm as well as pattern. Apical and radial rates at 98. Radial pulses 2+ and pedal pulses 1+ with no signs of edema. Nail beds pink and capillary refill < 2 seconds

**Gastrointestinal** (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to

palpation) Patient was not able to verbalize last stool including color and consistency. Abdomen is soft to touch with no tenderness to palpation. Bowel sounds hyperactive x 4
