Wait in room to admin syringe in IV pump over 15 min 2. Flush with NS after 15 min to get full med out of tubing 3. In a newborn, assess for pain reactions such as inconsolable crying to watch for stomach pain 4. Also asses for allergic reactions such as a rash, hives, increased temp to monitor for a penicillin allergy
Ceftazidime	Cephalosporin	Fights bacterial infection meningitis	100 mg/mL, IV, 165mg dose: 50mg/kg q 8 hrs	Yes Choose an item. 1.65mL = 165mg of 100mg/mL	IV rate 3.3 mL/hr over 30 min	Stomach cramps or tenderness, bloating, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting	1. Flush with NS after 30 min to get full med out of tubing 2. Assess for allergic rxn such as hives, redness, increased temp 3. Watch for and document vomiting/spitting up after med admin and alert MD 4. Use N PASS scale, after admin to determine if he is in any pain caused by the med (ex: inconsolable crying)

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Chlorhexidine	Mouth/throat/dental agent	Chemo requirement that keeps the mouth from getting sores	15 mL PO	Yes Choose an item.	N/A	Change in taste, staining of teeth	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Swish in mouth for 15-30 seconds and spit into a cup to dispose (do not swallow) Assess for mouth sores commonly caused by cancer to make sure med is effective. Minimal staining by the mouth wash is normal Alert nurse if feeling an irritation in the mouth and throat such as itching or burning
Gabapentin	anticonvulsant	Seizure med/nerve pain	600mg dose: 2 300mg capsules	Yes Choose an item.	N/A	Slow breathing, drowsiness, dizziness, muscle weakness	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Respiratory depression is the largest side effect so respiratory assessments must be completed prior to admin and after. Report peripheral edema to nurse Fatigue from gabapentin can lead to decreased exercise and weight gain Do not take with strong painkillers as adverse effects can be exacerbated
Acetaminophen	analgesic	Pain relief	650mg tablet q 4 hrs prn	Yes Choose an item.	N/A	Diarrhea, nausea, vomiting	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Report black tarry stools to MD Do not take more than 4000mg in 24 hrs if pt weighs over 110 lbs Do not take if pt is already experiencing
