- Enlarged liver and spleen, jaundice, bone deformities, skin rashes, blindness, and meningitis




What am I going to see during my assessment?

The babies skin may have a yellow tint or yellow sclera of the eyes. Baby may have a skin rash, runny nose, swollen joints, and abnormal bone development,



What tests and labs will be ordered?

Lumbar puncture, nontreponemal serological, treponemal test, RPR titer, eye exam, meconium stat, cord stat, XR bone survey



What trends and findings are expected?

What medications and nursing interventions/treatments will you anticipate?

10 day antibiotic treatment (penicillin G), eye exam, hearing test, blood test, topical ointment for skin lesions
